G3 – Sat. 4:30-5:30PM

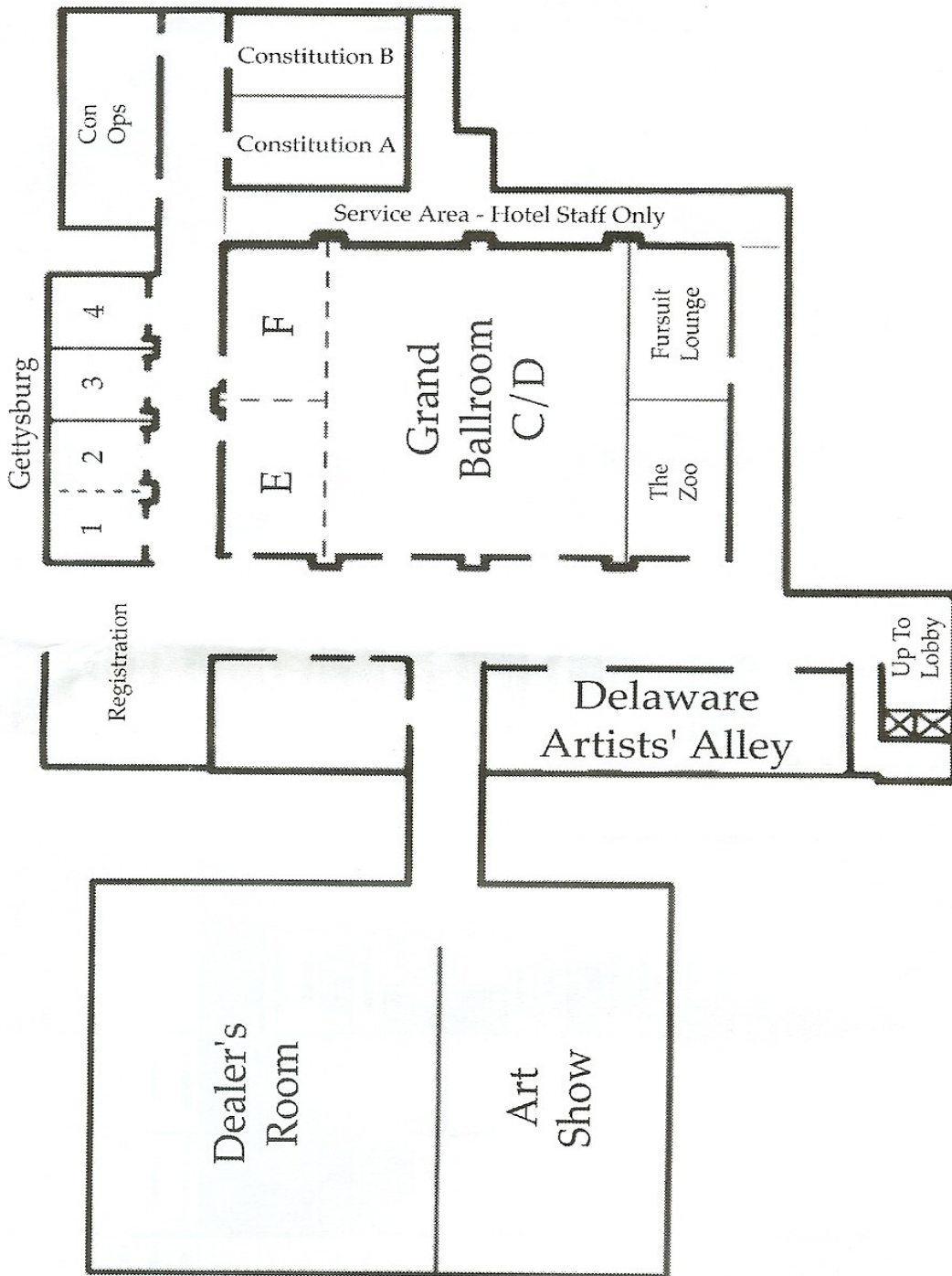

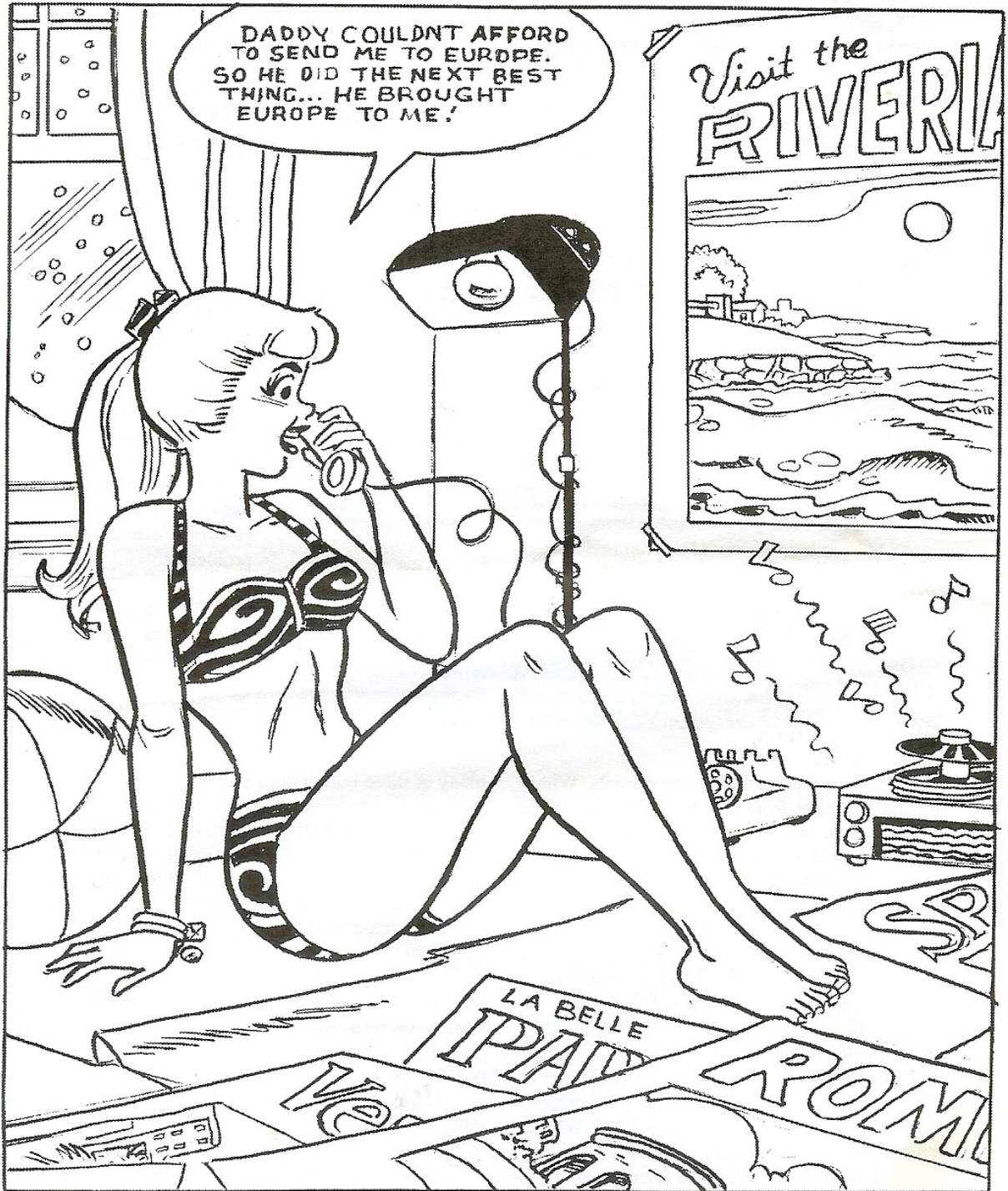
